## Program Description

The Elementary School at Paradise ISD is a school wide campus which means all students are receiving services. Students are identified for extra assistance by failure to meet standard on the State of Texas Assessment of Academic Readiness (STAAR-Grade 3); or through results of progress monitoring instruments- DRA K-3 reading, and NWEA Mapping in math and reading.

Reading and Math specialists are utilized in both pullout and classroom support to accelerate learning. Educational software is used to individualize instruction and assist with progress monitoring data management.

## Program Evaluation

Annual evaluation is done by disaggregation of test scores and data as required by TEA. Areas of program weakness are identified and addressed in goals and objectives for program improvement in the Campus Improvement Plan. Training areas are identified, as needed.
