Dear Parents/Guardians,

Congratulations on being one semester closer to graduation of your student. Your student will be walking across the stage before you know it. There are several important dates and deadlines coming in the 2nd semester of which I would like to make you aware. Please refer to the following information:

Scholarships: There will be MANY scholarships available on Mrs. Kronenberger's webpage this spring. Check out the scholarship tab on her webpage weekly so you don't miss any deadlines. Scholarships provide a great opportunity to gain money for college.

Senior Send-Off: Mark your calendar now, for the Class of 2018 Senior Send-Off. This year's event will be held on Friday, May 18th, beginning at 1:30 PM in the high school gym. Please bring proof of any scholarships that you've received to Mrs. Kronenberger as soon as possible, so that you can be recognized. This includes scholarships received from colleges, universities, the military, or any other organizations. The scholarship presentation will be followed by the senior slide show. **May 18th is currently scheduled as a bad weather day with no school. If we do NOT have school on May 18th, Senior Sendoff will be held Thursday, May 17th at 1:30 PM.**

Senior Slide Show: Coach Mitschke's classes will be completing the senior slide show during the 5th 6 weeks of school. All pictures and information needs to be submitted to Coach Mitschke by the end of the 4th 6 weeks (February 20th).

Senior Wall: Once you've been accepted to a college or branch of the military AND are committed to attending that college or branch of the military, bring your letter of acceptance to Mrs. Kronenberger to claim your senior block on the wall. Basic paint and supplies are provided by the school.

Senior Dues and Trip: Senior Dues will be collected by January 31st without a late fee. Final deadline will be Friday, February 16th. This will allow time to plan your senior trip. If you choose not to pay your class dues, you will not participate in the senior trip.

Final Transcripts: You will be provided a form to request your final high school transcript during the last week of school after the senior group photo session. Along with the college that you will be attending, you will need to list Weatherford College if you have taken dual credit courses through WC.

May 22nd – Senior Class Trip

May 23rd – Elementary Walk – Report to the Elementary Library

May 24th – Senior Breakfast – 8:00 a.m. Graduation Practice will immediately follow. Plan on 2 hours. If you choose not to attend mandatory practice, you will not participate in the graduation ceremony.

May 25th – No Senior Activities

May 26th – Graduation at Weatherford High School beginning at 2:00 p.m. Students should arrive at 12:30 p.m. Doors open for everyone else at 1:00 p.m.
